Team Selection Policy

1. A panel of 3 selectors, elected annually by the members of the Club, shall be responsible for selection of all teams representing the Club
2. Teams representing the Club in competitions held under the auspices of Bowls Cyprus shall be chosen on the basis of attempting to provide the strongest team available. As well as bowling ability other factors will be considered such as but not restricted to historical reliability, conduct and harmonious play
3. Selection of teams representing the club in other matches or competitions will attempt to produce a balanced team of suitable strength and will, where appropriate, include players who wish to play competitively but would not normally be included in teams chosen under paragraph 2 above. Over a series of matches, players in the latter category will be given a fair opportunity to play, commensurate with their ability, reliability and the strength of the opposition
4. Members of the club who are known to regularly leave the rink during play, will not normally be considered for selection as skip
5. Where time permits, availability sheets will be posted on the notice board at least two weeks before a fixture and team sheets, with a space for each team member to confirm availability. Teams will be displayed for at least two club roll up days before a match
6. Teams will always be selected to reflect the best interests of the club
7. Members wishing to be considered for team selection are encouraged to participate in appropriate training sessions organised by the club
